Class 1 – Young stock Open Foal. Open to any age( up to 11 months) , any type, breed . Weaned or Unweaned filly/colt or gelding. Exhibit must be lead by handler 14 yrs & over! Halters no bits!.

Class 2 – Young stock Open Yearling. Halters or in hand bridles. Colts, Gelding or Filly of any type /breed.

Class 3 – Young stock Open 2 yrs old . Halter or in hand bridle. Colt, Filly or Gelding any type or breed.

Class 4 – Young stock Open 3 year old. In hand bridle or halter. Colt, Filly or Gelding any type or breed.

Class 7 – IN HAND PART BRED HORSE OR PONY – Open to registered or non registered. Any Age & height. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Filly, Stallion. There will be a special class at the finals for part bred qualifiers who have been placed (top 6) throughout the season in any of our series .

Class 8 – IN HAND PURE BRED HORSE OR PONY – Open to registered or non registered, any age, height, breed . Mare, Colt, Gelding Stallion or Filly. This also includes RoR/TBs.

Class 9 – IN HAND OPEN HORSE OR PONY. Open to registered or non registered. Any age & height. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 10 – IN HAND OPEN HUNTER – any type or breed. Light/Medium/Heavy ,Any age & height. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 11 – IN HAND OPEN PONY – Any age height up to 148cms. Mare, Filly, Gelding, Colt or Stallion.

Open to all RoR and NR **competition registered** horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR Open In-Hand class. Horses can be shown in a bitless/In-Hand Bridle. Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force.

Handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at The Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree, August 24th 2024

CLASS 15 -\* IN HAND CHILD HANDLER. OPEN TO JUNIORS UP TO THE AGE OF 15 YRS. ROSETTES GIVEN TO 3 AGE GROUPS - 3 TO 6 YRS - 7 TO 10 YRS - 11 TO 15 YRS. . 3 TO 6 YRS MAY HAVE ASSISTANCE IN THE RING. EXHIBITS MARES OR GELDINGS ONLY.

CLASS 16 – \* IN HAND SENIOR HANDLER –OPEN TO ADULTS 16 YRS & OVER. EXHIBITS ANY AGE, BREED/TYPE & HEIGHT.

CLASS 17 – \* IN HAND MINIATURE & SHETLAND CLASS. OPEN TO ANY HEIGHT, BREED / TYPE & AGE. REGISTERED OR UNREGISTERED.

CLASS 18 - IN HAND BEST MARE. OR FILLY. OPEN TO ANY HEIGHT, BREED / TYPE & AGE.

CLASS 19 - IN HAND BEST GELDING, COLT OR STALLION. OPEN TO ANY HEIGHT, BREED / TYPE & AGE.

CLASS 20 -\* BEST COMBINATION IN HAND. OPEN TO ANY HEIGHT, BREED / TYPE & AGE.

CLASS 21 -\* BEST NOVICE COMBINATION IN HAND. OPEN TO ANY HEIGHT, BREED / TYPE & AGE.

CLASS 22 - \* IN HAND COB - SHOW OR TRADITIONAL SOLID OR COLOURED.

CLASS 23 -\* IN HAND FOREIGN & RARE BREEDS & BRITISH TB. Any height Mare, Gelding or stallion, filly or colt, registered or unregistered.

CLASS 24 -\* IN HAND COLOURED. Open to Plaited or non plaited. Unusual colour inc. Any age, Mare, Filly, Colt, Gelding or Stallion.

CLASS 25 – CONCOURSE DE ELEGANCE please note this can be entered either in hand or ridden – Class will be split & placed according to entries. – 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> ridden – 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> in hand.

Class 26 – Ridden T&T Open to any exhibit/exhibitor, Lead Rein inc. This is line up only no show.

Class 27 – Ridden Open Lead Rein. Open to child up to & inc 9 yrs of age in the current yr. Pony height up to & inc 128cms. Lead Rein Must be attached to the nose band, wilkies/snaffles only!.

Class 28 – Ridden Open 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden. Open to child up to & inc 12 yrs of age in current year. Pony up to & inc 128cms.

Class 29 – Ridden M&M Small Breeds. To inc registered & non registered welsh A – B – EXMOOR – DARTMOOR – SHETLAND – Rider any age, . Mare or Gelding 4 yrs & over. Any Bridle. Stallions allowed by riders 14 yrs & over. . Lead Reins Allowed wilkie/Snaffle Bits only!.

Class 30 – Ridden M&M Large Breed. To inc all reg & non reg Welsh C – D – HIGHLAND – DALES – FELL – NEW FOREST – CONNEMARA – Rider any age. Exhibits 4 yrs of age & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Any bridle!.

Class 31 – Ridden Part Bred Horse or Pony. Registered or Unregistered. Aged 4 yrs & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Any bridle, Lead Reins Allowed. There is a separate award for the highest placed Appaloosa.

Class 32 – Ridden Hunter. Open to any Light/Medium or Heavy Weight. 4yrs of age & over. Mare, Stallion or Gelding. Any type/Breed, height. Any Age of Rider. Lead Reins Allowed for SHP.

Class 33 – Ridden Pure Bred. Open to any breed British or Foreign. 4 yrs of age & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. This Class although includes the thoroughbred is not an RoR Qualifier!

Class 34 – Ridden Cob. Show Cob or Traditional. Solid or Coloured. Open to any height & weight. 4 yrs of age & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Lead Reins Allowed.

Class 35 – Ridden Horse. Open to any type or breed over 148cms. 4 yrs of age & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Rider 14 yrs & over.

## CLASS 36 A RIDDEN VHS AREA QUALIFIER FOR HORSES & PONIES 15 YRS OF AGE & OVER.

All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS 2024 Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. Only fully qualified **Members** holding a current VHS membership card and a VHS showing card with a valid qualification signature may enter. Both cards must be carried **in the ring** and produced on request – no exceptions will be made.

## RoR RIDDEN CLASSES... CLASS 36 B - Tattersalls RoR Open Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024

Thoroughbred mare or gelding, 4years old or over, any height. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited. **The first THREE go forward to the championship at Hickstead on June 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024.** All entries **MUST** be competition registered with the RoR and include their competition registration number on entry form and have **RACED in GB.** All those entering horses and/or participating in the show agree to be bound by the Retraining of Racehorses Rules and Regulations from time to time in force'. Please be aware that the show will split the class on the horse's last run in a race (NH or Flat) or will provide 2 ride judges should the entries exceed 20. Please mark your entry form accordingly. **Competitors must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap. Racing injuries and blemishes will NOT be ignored in this series** RoR rosettes 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> and a branded prize to be redeemed from the RoR Office the winner. **The winner also qualifies** for the Tattersalls RoR Open Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2024

## CLASS 36 C - Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024

### Tattersalls RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier 2024

Open to all RoR and NR competition registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 years or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the calendar year holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Horses should be plaited.

The Series is open to AMATEUR riders only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Racing injuries and blemishes ARE IGNORED in this series

The Judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the Final.

Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chinstrap.

The first three go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 23<sup>rd</sup> 2024

RoR rosettes  $1^{st} - 4^{th}$  and a branded prize to the winner. The winner also qualifies for the Tattersalls RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series Special at the Jockey Club RoR National Championships at Aintree on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2024.

### Amateur definition:

The rules are as in the rulebook with the following addition that an amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm. In addition, a person classed as amateur must

not be supported by a company in any way or act as brand ambassador whether financially or in-kind. An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard from January 1st, 2024. Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current season. A rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disgualification from future classes.

CLASS 37 -\* Ridden Grassroots / Novice lead Rein. Open to Riders who are beginners or very little experience in the show ring!. Must not have won more than 3 times in the previous year at county level!. Excluding Novelty!. Ponies can be any height 4 yrs of age & over. Snaffle bits only with lead rein attached to the nose band!. Children from the age of 3 yrs to 8 yrs. Mare or Gelding.

CLASS 38 –\* Ridden 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden Grassroots/Novice. Open to beginners or very little experience, must not have won classes more than 3 times in the previous year at county level. (Excluding novelty). Ponies can be any height 4 yrs of age & over. Snaffle bits only, Children aged up to 12 yrs!. Mare or Gelding. WALK/TROT CLASS.

CLASS 39 – Ridden Novice/Grassroots Pony. Open to Ponies that have not competed at county under saddle!, Aged 4 yrs & upwards, height up to 148cms, Rider any age. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Lead Reins Allowed. WALK/TROT CLASS

CLASS 40 – Ridden Novice/Grassroots Rider. Open to any age not to have competed at county level or won more than 3 times (exc Novelty). Pony/Horse any height aged 4 yrs & upwards, Mares & Geldings only. Snaffle/Pelham bridles. Lead Reins Allowed. WALK/TROT CLASS.

CLASS 41 – \*Ridden Coloured. Open to plaited / unplaited - unusual , piebald, spotted, skewbald , Tri coloured, Palomino, grey, Dun, Buckskin, Roan, silver. 4 yrs of age & over. Rider any age. Any bridle!. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Lead Reins Allowed.

CLASS 42 –\* Ridden New Combination. Open to any combination that has started out last season!. Exhibits 4 yrs of age & over, rider any age, Mare, gelding or stallion, Lead Reins Allowed.

CLASS 43 –\* Ridden Best Combination. Open to competitors of any age & exhibits 4 yrs & over, any height. Lead Reins allowed. Any Bridle!.

CLASS 44 – Ridden Mare. Open to any height of exhibit, 4 yrs of age & over, Rider any age, lead reins allowed. Any Bridle!.

CLASS 45 – Ridden Gelding / Stallion. Open to any height of exhibit, 4 yrs of age & over. Rider any age. Lead Reins Allowed. Any Bridle.

CLASS 46 –\* Ridden Foreign Breed. Open to any exhibit Registered or unregistered with a society. Any Height, Aged 4 yrs & over. Rider any age, Lead Reins Allowed.

RING 2 JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS, OPEN TO ALL EXHIBITORS AGED 17 & UNDER.

Both Champion & Reserve go through to the end of day overall supreme.

RING 2 SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS, OPEN TO ALL EXHIBITORS OVER THE AGE OF 17.

Both Champion & Reserve go through to the end of day Overall Supreme.
