This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> August 2024. The TWO highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

This show is also affiliated to Equine Sports UK, The Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK 25<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Top 3 places exhibits will qualify. Additional qualifiers are with the VHS tbh at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on 30<sup>th</sup> August -1st September 2024.

Class 1 – Young stock Open Foal. Open to any age, type, or breed. Weaned or unweaned filly, colt or gelding. Exhibit must be lead by handlers 14yrs & over. Halters no bits.

Class 2 - Young Stock Open Yearling. Halters or in-hand bridles. Colts, geldings or fillies of any Type or breed.

Class 3 - Young Stock Open two-year-olds. Halters or in-hand bridles. Colts, geldings or fillies of any Type or breed.

Class 4 - Young Stock Open three-year-olds. Halters or in-hand bridles. Colts, geldings or fillies of any Type or breed.

**Young Stock Championship – Open to all 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from each of the classes above. The Champion & Reserve will go forward to the in-hand supreme.**

Class 5 – In hand M&M Small Breed. Open to all M&M registered or unregistered. Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 6 – In hand M&M Large Breed. Open to all M&M registered or unregistered. Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 7 – In hand Part bred horse or pony. Open to registered or unregistered, Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly. Part bred qualifier classes the finals TBH @ The NRC Doncaster 13<sup>th</sup> Oct 24. Qualifier to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

Class 8 – In hand Pure bred horse or pony. Open to registered or unregistered, Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 9 – In hand Open horse or pony. Open to registered or unregistered, Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly. Handler to be 14yr or older.

Class 10 – In hand Open Hunter of any type or breed. Any age. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 11 – In hand Open Pony Any age up to 148cms. Mare, Gelding, Colt, Stallion or Filly.

Class 12A – VETERAN IN-HAND, COMBINED AGE CLASS (15 years and over)

To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories.

Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20-24) & Pre-Veteran (15-19). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.

VHS regional final qualification. All competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> each category will qualify for the corresponding classes at VHS regional finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have showing cards signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a read qualification card which can be exchange for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. **This must be done within 21 days of qualification.** It is the competitor's responsibility to present their showing card to the judge.

As wishing to join or renew the society will need to apply before the 1st of April each year or a late penalty fee of £15 will be charged.

**Regional finals are open to members only**

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the national veteran championships, to be held at Arena UK, Lincolnshire on the 30th of August to the 1st of September 2024. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2024.

**Please note Class 12 – In Hand Veteran is only a qualifier for the VHS area championships in our March/ April /May /July and October shows. June show will be standard veteran masters showing class with the schedule being the same for all other shows it will still be listed as a VHS qualifier.**

**AMATEUR DEFINITION** the rules are as in the rulebook with the following additions that the amateur may not show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm in addition a person classed as an amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as a brand ambassador whether financial or in kind. Any amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR CLASSES DOES NOT/HAS NOT DURING THE CURRENT SEASON OR PREVIOUS SEASON. Engaged in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity. All sides must not have been stable or resided in a professional producer / trainer yard from January 1st 2023. Riders must not have written any animals produced professionally are trained in the current or previous season. Horses and riders must not receive any help from a professional producer or trainer at a shirt in the current season. A writer who has written for a professional producer or trainer in the current or previous season must not have ridden horses at a show. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

**Class 12B – TATTERSALLS RoR Open in hand show series qualifier 2024 – Judge Helen Bell**

Open to all ROR & NR competition registered horses, 3yrs & over Fillies, mares & Geldings. Horses do not need to be shod to compete in the RoR in hand class. Horses can be sure in a bitless in-hand bridal. Blemishes calls through racing will be ignored. All those entering classes and or participating in the show agree to be bound by the rules of retraining of racehorses and regulations from time to time in force. Handlers/Grooms must wear safety kite marked hard hat with chin strap.

**CLASS 36B TATTERSALLS RoR AMATEUR RIDDEN SHOW SERIES QUALIFIER 2024.**

Open to all RoR & NR competition registered horses, 4yrs & over mares & geldings, owned, produced & ridden by an Amateur. Riders must be 15 yrs or over on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the calendar yr holding the classes. Horses should be ridden in a snaffle, Pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavasson nose band. Horses should be plaited.

The series is open to Amateurs only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under "riding horse" format without "type" being taken into consideration. Racing injuries & blemishes are ignored in this series. The judge will not ride at the qualifiers but will ride in the final.

Competitors/handlers/grooms must wear a safety/kite mark hard hat with a chin strap.

The 1<sup>st</sup> 3 go forward to the final at the Hickstead Derby Meeting June 22<sup>nd</sup> 2024.

**CLASS 38 – Ridden 1<sup>st</sup> Ridden Grassroots/Novice. Open to beginners or very little experience, must not have won classes more than 3 times in the previous year at county level. (Excluding novelty). Ponies can be any height 4 yrs of age & over. Snaffle bits only, Children aged up to 12 yrs!. Mare or Gelding.**

**CLASS 39 – Ridden Novice/Grassroots Pony. Open to Ponies that have not competed at county under saddle!, Aged 4 yrs & upwards, height up to 148cms, Rider any age. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Lead Reins Allowed.**

**CLASS 40 – Ridden Novice/Grassroots Rider. Open to any age not to have competed at county level or won more than 3 times (exc Novelty). Pony/Horse any height aged 4 yrs & upwards, Mares & Geldings only. Snaffle/Pelham bridles. Lead Reins Allowed.**

**CLASS 41 – Ridden Coloured. Open to plaited / unplaited - unusual , piebald, spotted, skewbald , Tri coloured, Palomino, grey, Dun, Buckskin, Roan, silver. 4 yrs of age & over. Rider any age. Any bridle!. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Lead Reins Allowed.**

**CLASS 43 – Ridden Best Combination. Open to competitors of any age & exhibits 4 yrs & over, any height. Lead Reins allowed. Any Bridle!.**

**CLASS 47 – TINY TOTS Inc LEAD REIN FINALS** Aged up to 8yrs Pony up to 122cms any breed or type Mare or Gelding aged 4 yrs & above. Snaffle bridles wilkies allowed. Jump height up to 35cms .

**CLASS 48 – GRASSROOTS PONY FINALS** - Open to 3 to 8 yrs, Pony height up to 128cms open to any type/breed Mare or Gelding 4 yrs of age & above. Snaffle bridles only wilkies allowed. Max Height of Jumps 40cms.

**CLASS 49 – NOVICE PONY FINALS**- Open to children up to the age of 15yrs. Pony height up to 148cms. Mare or Gelding 4 yrs of age & over. Snaffle or Pelham bridles only, no spurs. Jump Height Max 50cms.

**CLASS 50– OPEN PONY FINALS**- Any age of rider. Pony height up to 148cms, any type or breed. Any bridle. Aged 4 yrs & over. Mare, Gelding or Stallion. Jump Height Max 70cms.

**CLASS 51 – GRASSROOTS HORSE FINALS**- Any height from 148 & upwards. Any age of rider from 15 yrs+. Mare, Gelding 4 yrs of age & over. Snaffle or Pelham bridles allowed. No Spurs. Max Height of Jumps 70cms.

**CLASS 52 – NOVICE HORSE FINALS** – Any height over 148cms & upwards. Any age of rider from 15 yrs+. Mare, Gelding or Stallion 4 yrs of age & over. any breed or type, any suitable bridle allowed no long whips or spurs. Jump up to Max Height 75cms.

**CLASS 53 – M&M FINAL SMALL** – Open to Welsh A, B, Exmoor, Dartmoor, Shetland, registered or unregistered. Any bridle, riders any age. Mare, Gelding or Stallion aged 4 yrs & over. Max Jump Height 65cms.

**CLASS 54 – M&M FINAL LARGE** – Open to Breed registered or unregistered, Welsh , C, D, Highland, Connemara, New Forest, Fell, Dales, Eriskay. Any suitable bridle, any age of rider. Pony age from 4 yrs & over. Mare, gelding or stallion. Max Height of Jumps 75cms.

**CLASS 55– OPEN HORSE FINALS** – Open to any breed or type, height from 148cms & upwards. Aged from 4yrs & over. Any bridle. Mare, gelding or stallion. Max Height of Jumps 90cms

The classes are designed to introduce grassroots / novice/ nervous for either exhibit or exhibitor to working hunter classes, We have also inc a couple of classes that may encourage exhibits that have jumped before but are in need of refreshers!. As a new type of competition , you will enter 1 at a time to do your individual show, You will do your individual show then Precede straight into the jumping phase made up of only 3 or 4 elements of rustic fences. Once you have completed, your judge will mark your points for each section down , you may then leave the ring & the next competitor may enter. The rules are kept simple so that you all can come along & experience worker jumps in a competition but without the need to do a full course which for many can seem very stressful or intimidating. There are no rules that an experienced exhibit cannot enter but the exhibitor must fit the criteria of the class description or disqualification may happen, the same for the exhibitor, you may enter a grassroots/novice exhibit as we realise that they too need to learn & need somewhere to compete before they move onto bigger things!, but again if anyone notifies us that a competitor is in the wrong class elimination sadly will be put into place. So it is up to the individual to make sure before entering you have read the simple rules & criteria for these classes we just want everyone to play fare & enjoy.

Placings go to top 6 in each class – Hard Hats must be worn at all times both on & off the exhibit – This is classed as a riding club style/level of show with no set rules as with societies but please be mindful that politeness & being kind to your fellow competitors is a must, we pride ourselves as a show that we won't stand any bullying or cat calling at the side of the ring, all our competitors deserve to take part & enjoy their experience equally, if anyone has any reason to make a complaint about another competitor then please come to the secretary area , on no circumstances must there be anything detrimental posted on social media without seeking advice on a matter 1<sup>st</sup> from officials. Please no spurs in the grassroots/novice classes – Any safety wear body protectors may be worn, you will not be marked down in turnout!.
